The children and their leader separated from the main group and proceeded at a faster pace. Fortunately it enabled the children to spot a Clapper Rail, something the remainder of the group could not do.

It was a good trip for all as forty species were sighted by the two groups.

Returning from a little rough riding on the East side of the Lexington Reservoir in the Santa Cruz mountains, just above the town of Los Gatos, I was treated to a little extra enjoyment to add to the morning's outing.

Rounding a curve in my Land Cruiser, I chanced on a large bird feeding on a fresh kill at the base of a steep embankment, fifty yards North of the intersection of Hillsdale Rock Co. road and Alma Bridge Road at an elevation of 715 feet above sea level.

As I drew to within a distance of sixty feet or so, I remarked to my partner, Warren Butman, that the bird appeared to be a young eagle. The remark did not bring the expected reaction, so I stopped the vehicle and told the others to sit tight while I made better identification of the bird.

Approaching slowly and talking to the animal, I got to within six or eight feet of the very obviously most hungry bird. It evidenced no fear of man as it continued to rip off large chunks of its freshly killed gopher snake that must have approached four and a half feet in length, before the reduction began. At this distance I began a study of some of the bird's features, that I might confirm my first identification on my return home.

The bird was a young Golden Eagle; it still had a few white downy feathers poking through the large golden feathers on its back. The broad tail feathers were of a lighter golden brown. The legs were very stocky, yellow and well covered with chap like feathers to within a short distance of the proportionately large talons. The beak was very curved with notches back of the hook. The nostril area had a yellowish plastic appearing band bridging the upper beak.

Having made note of some of the bird's features, I decided to see how close I could approach; of course this brought on a series of shrill shrieks of protest as the bird raised his head from the feeding. At a distance of three feet, he spread his wings forming a canopy over the treasured food. In this position one could hardly see the Animal's head as it continued eating. With its head toward the embankment and I right at its rear, the creature was more or less doomed to staying put. At this point (talking in the most reassuring tone at my command I proceeded to touch the Eagle's back on two occasions; needless to say this was not appreciated too much by the other half.

Having completed by observation, I told Warren to take the Toyota home and come back with his camera as he would not have the opportunity to get a picture like this again in a lifetime. I stayed with the Eagle knowing it to be protected by Federal Law, and also being aware that young boys are prone to stoning such perfect set-ups.

Several cars stopped and spilled out their interested occupants but I asked them to please stay away from the bird. All were curious yet cooperative, barring one individual who roared up in his Jeep and spooked the young Eagle. It wheeled around and came right toward me; I showed courtesy and side stepped to allow the bird to make its way to the far side of the road where there was a small berm and a drop of approximately fifty degrees down through the brush and trees to the lake's edge. All this time the young bird was handicapped by having to drag the remaining generous portion of the snake behind him. When he topped the berm at the roadside there was a large bush that stalled the takeoff. He would have to move twenty feet or so to the right to gain a path through the trees. At this point Warren drew up with camera in hand, but as the Eagle was in deep (Cont'd.)

shadow under the bush, a good picture was all but impossible. Something had to be done. Knowing by this time that the creature was not about to relinquish his hold on the snake; I did it :- Grabbed the snake by the tail and brought the whole smear out into the sunlight. This move brought a little resentment from my feathered friend, so I backed off while the picture taking went on. Friend Eagle had made his way back up on the berm to a good point of departure.

Meanwhile my not so friendly friend in the Jeep, having several times remarked that he would like to have the bird, returned with a large sheet of what appeared to be heavy toweling and said he was going to take that bird. I informed him that he was not and that if I had to I would pull rank. This statement made him back off.

Mr. Golden had evidently received orders from the tower, for in one swoop lunch in hand, he was off the berm threading his way through the brush and trees like a champion, disturbing not a twig.
